# Revised Safety Development Unit (SDU) Framework 2023

#### **Continuing Professional Development (CPD)**

- The Continuing Professional Development (CPD) programme helps workplace safety and health (WSH) officers stay up to date and expand their knowledge
  - Objective: Ensure WSHOs stay relevant and competent in the environment that WSHOs operate
- The Safety Development Units (SDU) framework is part of the CPD programme for WSHOs, administered through the WSHO renewal requirements

#### **Key Objectives for the SDU Framework Review**

- 1. Streamlining the WSH practice process for WSHO registration
- 2. Encourage continuing professional development for WSH professionals
- 3. Enable WSHOs to stay abreast of changing industry needs and to remain competent in the evolving environment in and from which they operate

#### **SDU Categories under Revised SDU Framework**

Category 3 is managed by MOM and evidences are required for all renewal applications.

#### Revised SDU Framework from 1st Jan 2023

#### From 1 Jan 2023

- WSHOs can submit the SDUs under the revised SDU categories
- WSHOs can still renew the registration with SDUs obtained under the previous SDU framework (structured/unstructured categories) within the last two years.
- Courses which do not fulfil the CPD objectives, under the revised SDU framework, shall
  no longer be eligible for the SDU awards.
- MOM shall continue to monitor and ensure the integrity of the SDU framework and relevancy of the SDU courses and courses/training offered by the training providers are assessed fairly under the CPD programme.

## Revised CPD Accreditation Process for SDU Category 2 – Accredited Training / Activities

#### For Training Providers and Organisers

Courses which do not fulfil the CPD objectives, under the revised SDU framework, shall no longer be eligible for the SDU awards.

Proposed training/activities must contain elements that enable WSHOs to:


- Maintain, improve, or increase their WSH knowledge;
- Keep abreast of evolving WSH procedures and standards;
- Understand and apply the latest knowledge and skills in WSH;
- Better serve the safety profession, the community and the environment;
- Develop communication, management skills, and professional ethics
- Broaden the essential skills and knowledge to function more effectively as WSHOs. These may include but are not limited to fields such as management, technology, environmental management and legal knowledge.



#### WSH Trainers to conduct effective training

- Training Providers training courses ( usually one trainer ).
- Organiser Organisation that organises and holds activities like conferences, seminars, symposium, forums, conventions, focus discussions. in-person or webinars with many professional speakers.





Training providers are required to provide the profile of each trainer in standard template (Appendix D) to enable the CPD Administrator to verify if the trainer possesses the qualifications or knowledge acceptable to the Board. For example:

- a) Is a WSHO holding a valid and current registration certificate issued by MOM and also has more than 5 years of practical experience in the field of WSH
- b) Has attended relevant courses:
- ACLP (or previously ACTA) for trainer who conducts WSQ courses, and
- Code of Ethics for WSH Trainers if Training Provider is a TP or an ISO 29993 certified LSP
- a) In the case of a non-WSHO, the trainer shall possess recognised tertiary education or relevant qualifications in the field of practice and good professional standing.

Training Providers have to submit copies of certificates or documentary testimonial to support the credentials of their trainer.


#### **Application Process**

Organisers/Training Providers are to complete the "Application for Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Programme Accreditation" form (Appendix C) and submit it to the Board,

via CPD Administrator c/o SISO <a href="mailto:cpd@siso.org.sg">cpd@siso.org.sg</a> four weeks before the start of the training/activity.

#### Conditions for the approval of SDU

- 9.1 The SDU is granted to the Training Providers / Organisations under the following conditions:
  - The approved SDU points is approved for the stated date and training/activities only.
  - Attendees must attain at least 75% of the attendance to be eligible for the approved SDU points and SDU points shall not be awarded for re-runs or refresher training.
  - Participants shall be awarded a certificate with:
    - The same "Course Title" as what was approved in the application form
    - The approved CPD code and SDU, as approved by the Board.
    - Participants' names, and NRIC/FIN with only the last three digits and alphabet printed (e.g.SXXXX123X).
    - For WSQ courses, additional letter to be issued using the template.
- Send a copy of the attendance file, as per template, to the CPD Admin within a month from the completion of the event.
- To clearly reflect the names of WSHO attendees, and to indicate "NIL" for non-WSHOs in attendance
- Failure to comply with the requirements may result in the suspension or termination of the account as a course organizer with the CPD board.
- Any other conditions that may be imposed by the Board on the application.

#### Note:

• For the Occupational First Aid Course (OFAC), WSHO can only claim SDU points once; repeat or refresher training shall not be eligible for any SDU point. Training Provider is to inform and check with the participants before registering the course and before issuing the certificate with SDU points (Training Provider is advised to indicate this in their brochure).







#### **Key Takeaway for Training Providers**

- 1. TP/EO to print the course/event title on the certificate of attendance as the same title stated in the application form.
- 2. TP/EO to print the participant's name, NRIC (last four characters), course/event title, date of course/event, CPD code and SDU accorded for the accredited course/event on the certificate of attendance or completion.
- 3. TP/EO is to conduct or hold the course/event within the accreditation window. Holding courses/events outside the accreditation window will automatically make the accreditation invalid.
- 4. TP/EO has to submit their application at least FOUR weeks before the commencement of their course/event (apply for renewal).
- 5. TP/EO has to ensure their trainers of WSQ courses have the necessary qualifications and training requirement for example COE course for WSH Trainers; ACTA or ACLP; WSHO valid licence
- 6. TP/EO is not to apply for CPD accreditation after the course/event

#### Key Takeaway for Training Providers

- 7. If SOA issued does not have CPD code and SDU accorded for the accredited course printed on it, TP has to issue a letter to certify the attendance of the participant. The content of the letter must bear the organisation/company letterhead and details as per the template highlighted in the briefing
- 8. TP/EO is to use the one and only CPD code issued to them for the particular course/event. CPD code other than the given code issued upon accreditation will not be valid.
- 9. TP/EO is to stick to the SDU awarded for the accredited course/event. The SDU awarded cannot be unilaterally increased nor reduced.
- 10. TP/EO is not to apply for accreditation more than 6 months before course date.
- 11. TP/EO is not to apply for accreditation, only courses that are more than three hours will be considered.


